5 Marks Distribution For Internal Examination And External Evaluation

The external examination of all semesters shall be conducted by the University at the end of each semester. Internal evaluation is to be done by continuous assessment.

5.1 Internal Evaluation

All the three components of the internal assessment are mandatory. For common course English in I Semester, internal oral examination shall be conducted instead of test paper.

5.1 Assignments

Assignments are to be done from 1st to 4th Semesters. At least one assignment should be done in each semester.

5.2 Seminar/Viva

A student shall present a seminar in the 5th semester and appear for Viva-voce in the 6th semester.

5.3 Internal Assessment Test Papers

At least one internal test-paper is to be attended in each semester for each course. The evaluations of all components will be published and is to be acknowledged by the candidates.

5.7 Grievance Redressal Mechanism

In order to address the grievance of students regarding the marks obtained in the internal assessment, a two-level Grievance Redressal mechanism is envisaged in the college. A student can approach the upper level only if grievance is not addressed at the lower level.\

5.8 External examination

5.8.1 The external examination of all semesters shall be conducted by the University at the end of each semester. Students having a minimum of 75% average attendance for all the courses only can register for the examination. Condonation of shortage of attendance to a maximum of 10 days or 50 hours in a semester subject to a maximum of 2 times during the whole period of the programme may be granted by the University on valid grounds. This condonation shall not be counted for internal assessment.

Benefit of attendance will be granted to students attending University/College union/Co-curricular activities by treating them as present for the days of absence, on production of participation/

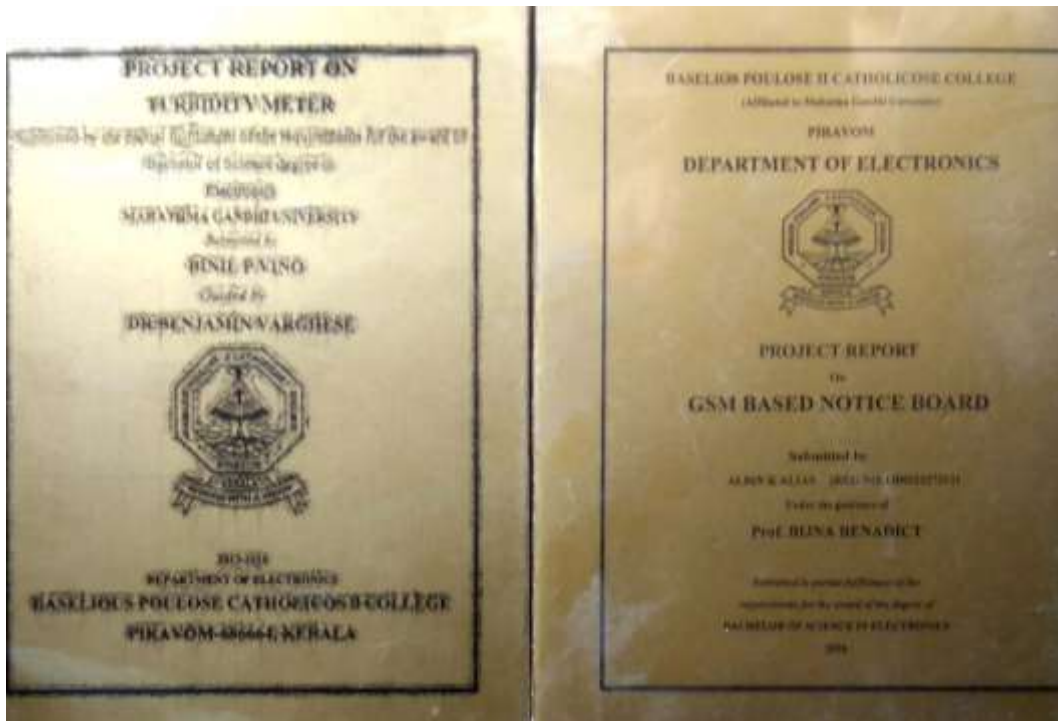


